UCMAS: Our children challenged themselves finding small friends for numbers, creating space for numbers which cannot be added directly on the UCMAS tools and challenged themselves using formulas to add and subtract numbers with the aid of a story on a small friend.

IN OUR CLASSROOMS:

PRE-SCHOOL (Nurs. 1 & 2): Our Caterpillars and Butterflies discussed family celebrations and festivals such as Naming Ceremony, Birthday, wedding celebration and many more. They were very excited when reciting the poem "Munchy Little Caterpillar. Our Butterflies challenged themselves during the discussion of family celebrations. French song: Vole, vole, vole papillon

KG 1 & 2: Our Cheetahs and Jaguars discussed leaders in our community and the roles they play. The Cheetahs considered the letter "I" and challenged themselves with words with the sound /i/ as in sit, lid, fit. DOLPHINS (Basic 1&2): The Snr Dolphins discussed simple machine in Science class. They appreciated the meaning and identified simple machines used in the home. In Maths class, they subtracted and added cedis (money). Jnr Dolphins were seriously finding more than and less than of given numbers under Basic Addition in Maths class. They had a discussion on Electricity. The Dolphin identified items that use electricity and were excited when asked to draw and colour any of them.

WHALES (Basic 3 &4): The Jnr Whales in Science class, discussed the sources of electricity such as wind, hydro and sun, compared two things without using as or like (Metaphor) in English Literature class, and ordered fractions in Maths class.
