.MUSIC CLASS, Basic 2,3,4,5 and 7 were seriously playing lessons from the music book, our Jnr. Dolphins still on theory and fingering exercise and Our Cheetahs and Jaguars were taken through fingering exercise.

UCMAS: Our children challenge themselves using formulas to subtract numbers with the aid of a story on a small friend. Challenged themselves finding small friends for numbers, creating space for numbers which cannot be added directly on the UCMAS tools.

IN OUR CLASSROOMS:

PRE-SCHOOL (Nurs. 1 & 2): Our Caterpillars in Numeracy class identified and traced the number “2”, challenged themselves with words with the sound /s/. as in snake, sit, sick and many more. The Butterflies considered animals and their homes in OWOP class and challenged themselves with words with the sound /i/ as in kid, kit, ink and the rest

KG 1 & 2: Our Cheetahs in Numeracy class challenged themselves counting, identifying and writing number 1-60, the tricky words of the week were “all” and “the”, and the rhyme of the week was “This Old Man”. The Jaguars in OWOP class discussed the sources and uses of water, showing the time using the clock in Numeracy class, and challenged themselves with words with the /a/, /m/ and /t/ sounds as in man, team, ant, tea, and many more. The story of the week was “Ungrateful Ananse” In French class discussed “ Les jours de la semaine”

DOLPHINS (Basic 1&2): The Jnr Dolphins in Science class discussed Living and Non-living Things and considered the characteristics of plants and animals, challenged themselves In Maths class ordering numbers and completing a given patterns, identified the proper nouns in given simple sentences in Eng. Grammar Usage class, The Snr Dolphins discussed the things that make one unique (Self-Identity) in OWOP class, challenged themselves with skip counting in Maths class. And in French class, our Dolphins discussed “Les adjectif, les jours de la semaine

WHALES (Basic 3 &4): The Jnr Whales in Science class discussed Hygiene, keeping the environment clean and the tools used, considered counting numbers 1 to 1,000,000, our Whales in French class were engaged in “Savoir presenter quelqu’ud” (Introducing someone), discussed how to open and the uses of power point in I.C.T. class. The Snr Whales (Basic 4) in English, Grammar Usage class, treated adverb of manner.

BASIC 7: Our Basic 7 discussed the types of prose such as Fable, Adventure, Allegory and the rest in Literature class, challenged themselves with number pattern (one to billion) discussed the Environment, the factors that degrade the environment and in Science class discussed the natural and artificial sources of water.
