UCMAS: Our children challenged themselves finding small friends for numbers, creating space for numbers which cannot be added directly on the UCMAS tools and challenged themselves using formulas to add and subtract numbers with the aid of a story on a small friend

MUSIC CLASS, Basic 2,3,4,5 and 7 were seriously playing lessons from the music book; our Jnr. Dolphins still on theory and fingering exercise and our Cheetahs and Jaguars were taken through fingering exercise.

IN OUR CLASSROOMS:

PRE-SCHOOL (Nurs. 1 & 2): Our Caterpillars and Butterflies discussed “The Human Body”, identified and traced the numbers two (2) and three (3). They were very excited when challenged themselves with letters B and C, and words with the sound /b/ as in boy, bag, bat .and many more, and were excited when blended with a rhyme

KG 1 & 2: The Cheetahs (KG 2) discussed words with the sound /or/ as in Lord, born, pork and many more. The story of the week was “David and Goliath”, and challenged themselves with number bonds in Numeracy class. Our Jaguars appreciated and challenged themselves with words with the sounds /m/ in Literacy class as in mat, mam, moon and the rest. The Story of the week was “Egya Nimo’s Dog” and considered “The Human Body” in French class.

DOLPHINS (Basic 1&2): The Snr Dolphins discussed Proper Nouns in Eng. Gram. Usage class, discussed Materials and their characteristics in Science class, and treated Ordinals in Maths class, challenged themselves ordering items from 1st to 10th position. The Jnr Dolphins were seriously showing direction in OWOP class. They had a discussion on Materials, using the senses to determine the texture, size and colour in Science class. Our Dolphins drew and coloured shapes using paint application in ICT class

WHALES (Basic 3 &4): The Jnr Whales discussed the states of matter; solid, liquid and gas states, in Science class. They also compared numbers using < or > or = in Maths class. and in History class, the Origin of the Akan People. The Snr. Whales in Science class discussed the types of mixtures: Liquid, liquid mixture, Solid, solid mixture and Liquid and Solid mixture, and Roman Numerals in Maths class. The Upper Whales in I.C.T class discussed personalization of the Computer, also challenged themselves with Roman numerals, considered number 1- 50 in Maths class.
